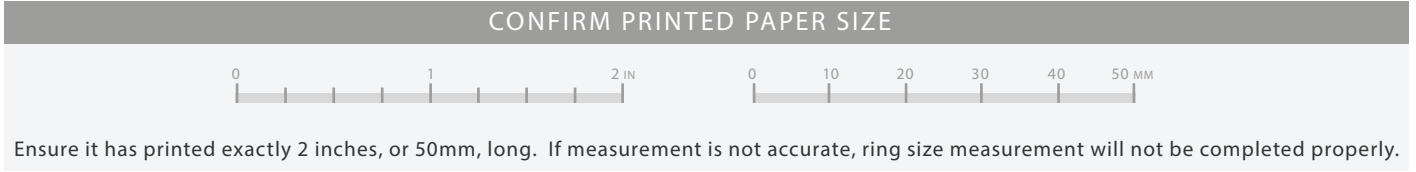




INSTANT RING SIZER GUIDE.

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

Before you start measuring, use a ruler to make sure the box below is the correct size, using your ruler.

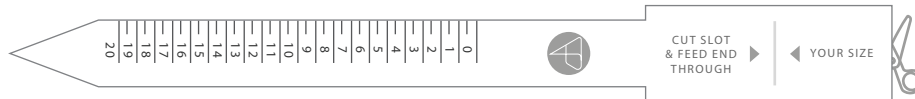


If using option 1, measure your finger at the end of the day when it will be at its largest.

Do not measure your fingers when they are cold or damp, as they will be at their smallest.

OPTION 1 - FIND YOUR RING SIZE IN LESS THAN ONE MINUTE!

1. Cut out the ring sizer below.
2. Wrap the ring sizer snugly around the widest part of the intended finger, and insert the pointed end through the "Cut Slot" you made in the sizer.
3. Check the the number that lines up with the slit, this is your ring size! If your size is in between the lines, make sure to choose for the larger line so you don't order a ring that is too small!



OPTION 2 - MEASURE A CURRENT RING

1. Choose a ring that correctly fits the finger you are purchasing the ring for. In the united states the engagement ring and wedding band are most commonly worn on the "ring finger" of the left hand.
2. Lay the ring over each of the size circles below, until you are able to closely match the inside edge of the ring one of the circles on the guide.
3. If the ring falls between two of the sizes, order the quarter size in the middle.
